

Jeff Oxman who said, “ I can’t recall seeing one like it”. Fey decided to send the coin to Leroy Van Allen for possible assignment. “As many collectors are now seeking to assemble a complete set of 1878 Morgan dollars, any new variety, even sub-varieties, are significant finds”, according to Fey. “This is one of several varieties having a ‘mysterious’ dot’. Perhaps the most well known ‘dot’ varieties are the *Top 100* 1884 VAM 3 and 4, with large and small dots on both the obverse and reverse. There are several rare dot varieties known in 1921 as well.”
